Job Description Summary

- Drive optimization of schedules by balancing demand priorities against optimal production sequencing and efficient resource (facility/suite, equipment, staff, materials etc.) utilization
- Ensure all feedback regarding changes to existing plans is incorporated into schedules in timely manner
- Maintain detailed planning and scheduling master data in planning system to allow optimal use of system scheduling functionality
- Generate relevant KPI and operational measures to support identification of trends or root causing of sub-optimal performance
- Maintain accurate production schedule, providing data for the MRP process to meet production demands
- Review documents such as production schedules, work orders, and staffing tables to determine personnel and materials requirements, and material priorities

- Detail-oriented with excellent organizational skills. Ability to work under pressure and adapt to changes. Strong communication and teamwork skills
- Apprenticeship with strong working experience in the industry or academical degree in Supply Chain, Engineering, Pharmacy or related field
- Experience in operations /production / supply chain environment – preferably in the pharmaceutical industry
- Certification in Production and Inventory Management (APICS - CPIM) is preferred
- Strong experience in SAP and MS Office
- Fluency in German and English
