



GRADUATE INTERNS for September 2021

Founded in 2015, Le Régent is a Swiss boarding and day school with an international academic programme. Its modern campus in the heart of the Valais Alps in the stunning ski resort of Crans-Montana is designed for up to 300 students from Switzerland and around the world.

Le Régent follows a rigorous academic programme in English in preparation for the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme while nurturing the individual talents of each student with its diverse extracurricular offering, including sports, arts, music and mountain activities.

Le Régent has been under the guidance of [Institut Le Rosey](#) since August 2019.

We are seeking to appoint up to six graduate interns for the 2021-2022 school year. These are residential positions from September 2021 until the end of June 2022. They would suit recently qualified graduate students looking to take a break after their studies or someone who is considering the teaching profession in the future.

Duties will be varied and tailored to the skills and ambitions of those engaged, but would cover many aspects of school life. These might include any of the following: classroom or sports assistant, library duty, accompanying students in sports or outings, boarding duties, creating content (photos & videos) for our social media.

We would particularly welcome applications from candidates with interest or specialism in the following areas:

- Junior and Infant School (children aged 3-12) teaching assistant
- Junior School (children aged 7-12) boarding assistant
- Senior/Secondary school boarding assistant
- Sports and boarding assistant all ages
- Outdoor Education (further details in separate ad available on school website)

We are looking for flexibility, energy and experience of working with children; some knowledge of both English and French as well as a liking for outdoor activities and sports (especially winter sports) would be a distinct advantage as would a readiness to live in an alpine environment and a driving licence.



Le Régent will provide:

- A monthly allowance of CHF 1,200
- Air travel (if required) to and from Le Régent from the airport at the stagiaire's place of origin at the beginning and end of contract
- A ski pass for the season
- Board (three meals a day in term time), lodging (in a Régent boarding house), use of Le Régent's sports facilities
- Full Swiss health and accident insurance
- Right to school holidays as defined by the school calendar.

Le Régent is committed to the highest standards of safeguarding and candidates will be expected to provide evidence of their suitability to work with children.
