- Updating and checking the plant documentation, e.g. flow charts, zone and installation plans, parts lists, change management in accordance with GMP.
- Supporting the training of the plant team and workshop personnel with regard to process and plant knowledge as well as safety, hygiene, environment and quality (cGMP).

- University degree (mechanical engineering, process engineering), technical college degree (FH)/technical college (HF).
- Experience in the field of biotech/pharmaceutical production
- Good knowledge of GMP, COMOS (Plant Engineering Software), SAP.
- Ability to work independently and flexibly, strong teamwork skills.
- Good communication skills.
- Structured, focused and very well organised work behaviour.

- German (at least A2) and fluent English is a must.
