Job Description Summary

- Analysis of 5 years Businesses Plan and business strategy Review (Infrastructure's Outlook BSR 700 m CHF) , evaluation of future needs of Infrastructure's performance using existing databases (mid-term Investment plan, Project Pipeline) to develop feasibility and concept / URS accordingly.
- Deputy of Director Site Development and Site Master Planning and functional Lead in Matrix Organization
- Leading Projects as Project Director - Planning, Supervision and Execution of capital projects in various environment
- Deliver from task force multidisciplinary setup until capital projects, the according deliverables on time, within budget and according to requirements or specifications. Investment cost of infrastructure projects in the range of 10 – 100 Mio CHF.
- Develop and coordinate specific asset developments on a site master plan e.g. Lab Infrastructure : understanding organizational needs from various QC and non QC lab (Analytical Development, Process Development, R&D, Shared Infra Labs)
- Build, coordinate and manage the project team, also in complex environment with multi-stage build-outs with contractors, cross functional, local, regional or international.
- Project lead in early phase projects, ensure ideas & feasibility studies for short and long-term development, in close contact with operating infrastructure and project engineering
- Responsibility for cost, schedule and deliverables in all phases of capital projects as approved either with Engineering Study Requests or Capital Authorization Requests.
- Direct contact to and close collaboration with positions such as the Site Leadership Team, Engineering, Infrastructure and Operations, Project Managers, Project Safety, Environmental and QA leads as well as external contractors if applicable.

- A minimum of a 10-year experience in the field of Chemical Engineering or Development
- Masters / PhD in Engineering (Chemical or Mechanical)
- Track record in execution of large CAPEX projects in an industrial environment (Early / Late Stage)
- Fluent in both German and English

- Strong financial understanding of capital equipment projects in a production environment
- Team lead experience
- Technical knowledge and functional understanding of production equipment
- PMP, Lean Six Sigma Qualification is a plus
