- Evaluates with the PMO Head future needs of infrastructure's performance (mid-term Investment plan, project Pipeline) to develop feasibilities and concepts / URS' accordingly
- Builds, coordinates and manages project teams also in complex environment between Biologics and Small Molecules business growth and the Site Infrastructure
- Direct contact to and close collaboration with positions such as the Site Head and Site Leadership Team, Head of Growth Investment Services, Head of Site Infrastructure/Services, Head of Group Services, BU Heads

- Extensive experience in the field of leading CAPEX projects, ideally in the environment of Biologics and Chemical Infrastructure
- Track record in execution of large CAPEX projects in an industrial environment (Early / Late Stage)
