- Being accountable for leading specific projects within the SGIE department e.g. Lead the SGIE Strategy development, implement Lonza Business Management System, Ensure specific technology innovation and standardization
- Ensure that the portfolio of projects and initiatives within the department is appropriate and sufficient to deliver the function's strategic goals
- Work with cross-functional internal and external partners to improve to implement and execute strategic initiatives
